CREST Pursuing Higher Service Level for VicPD

Victoria, BC - At a meeting of the CREST board today, the decision was made to support moving to a higher level of service for the Victoria Police in the urban core. The Board also voted to work with the City of Victoria, as its shareholder, on funding alternatives.

“We are committed to working with the Victoria Police and all our members to provide the service they need,” said chair Gordie Logan. “CREST, the City of Victoria and VicPD are continuing to work together.”

CREST operates a wide-area radio system that processes a call every four seconds on average for 36 emergency service providers in the Capital Region.
